Candidates for the middle school principal position must have prior leadership experience and possess a successful leadership record. The candidates for this position will be carefully and prayerfully evaluated according to the following essential criteria:

- Professing Christian with a Biblically-sound faith experience that is clearly communicated;
- Practicing a solid personal faith-walk and active a local church;
- Holding a core belief in Biblical integration within a framework of academics, with the ability to implement and expand such a framework;
- Possessing the ability to create, direct, and maintain a total program which provides continuity and training that prepares students competitively;
- Leading through service, encouragement, and strength.

Additionally, the middle school principal must possess:

- Leadership acumen;
- Communication skills;
- Successful teaching experience;
- Understanding of best curricular practices in an academically rigorous setting;
- Love for working with students, faculty, and parents;
- Dedication to fostering the values that support an independent Christian school community.
- Resilience, flexibility, a sense of humor, and a commitment to working in a collaborative and fast-paced environment are also essential qualities;
- At least a master's degree in an appropriate field.
